ACTION TAKEN: Upon arrival to BRUCE ANDERSON's residence, I accompanied DIANE ANDERSON to the door. The door was opened by BRUCE ANDERSON's wife, and DIANE ANDERSON forced her way into the residence and began to get JEWELL ANDERSON out of the chair that she was resting comfortably in. At this time BRUCE ANDERSON arrived in the room and all parties began to argue. I asked to talk to BRUCE ANDERSON alone and had DIANE ANDERSON wait outside. I was advised by BRUCE ANDERSON that there is a custody dispute ongoing and JEWELL ANDERSON's court appointed guardian/conservator/public administrator had her placed at BRUCE's residence until the upcoming court date on January 10th. I then spoke with JEWELL ANDERSON's public administrator, TIM FLYNN, who confirmed the above with me and advised that he did not JEWELL in the care of DIANE ANDERSON until the situation is resolved in Oakland County Court. FLYNN advised that he had court documentation providing that he was JEWELL's administrator. After speaking with FLYNN, I advised BRUCE ANDERSON that I would leave the matter up to the court to decide and would not get involved. BRUCE ANDERSON asked me to have DIANE ANDERSON leave his property.

I asked DIANE ANDERSON if she knew who TIM FLYNN is and she admitted that he was JEWELL's public administrator, however "he is going to be disbarred." I attempted to explain to DIANE ANDERSON the situation, and that if she felt if there was a problem that she needed to pursue the matter through the court as her issue had to do with the court and the public administrator, not her brother. However, DIANE ANDERSON would not listen to anything that I had to say, instead she yelled at me and tried to have me talk to her lawyer. I advised her that her lawyer would not tell me how to go about my duties and if she wanted to have the court advise me otherwise between now and January 10th, then that would be taken into consideration. I then advised her that she needed to leave her brother's property as her brother advised me that she was trespassing. DIANE ANDERSON went back to the door and began to argue again with her brother. I finally advised her that she would be arrested for trespassing if she did not leave. DIANE ANDERSON then proceeded to insult me by saying to me that "They enforce the law better down in Detroit better than you people do up here" and other statements. I proceeded to wait out in my vehicle out on the roadway until DIANE ANDERSON complied with her brother's wishes.
