ORIGINAL REPORT

INFORMATION: I responded to a situation where a custody dispute between a brother and sister over their mother had become heated. Both parties request that a report be filed.

VENUE: [REDACTED] Richland Township, Montcalm County.

DATE AND TIME: 10/6/06 at 1826 hours.

DISPATCH INFORMATION: Dispatch instructed me to go to 8795 Phelps Drive where an unknown situation was developing. Dispatch informed me that a male caller was on the telephone and a female was in the background. They told me that the female was extremely agitated. That the female was screaming and that they were having a hard time determining what was going on at the scene.

When I arrived at the scene I made contact with DIANE ANDERSON and IAN CALDWELL. ANDERSON and CALDWELL were in the driveway near their vehicle.

ANDERSON told me that she was at the home of her brother. DIANE ANDERSON's mother is staying with her brother BRUCE ANDERSON. DIANE was attempting to visit her mother at her brother's house however her brother was denying her access to her mother.

DIANE ANDERSON tells me that she would like the police to enforce a court order which requires her brother to grant her access to her mother. I told ANDERSON that I would not be able to enforce such a court order unless I was able to see a copy of the court order for myself. DIANE ANDERSON told me that she did not have a copy of any court paperwork with her.

I then spoke with BRUCE ANDERSON. BRUCE ANDERSON states that he has custody of his mother. BRUCE ANDERSON states that there is a custodian who is in charge of his mother's affairs. This person was on the telephone with BRUCE ANDERSON at the time. I later spoke with him. His name was TIM. I am unsure of his last name.

BRUCE ANDERSON tells me that he is denying access to his mother so that DIANE will not upset their mother further. BRUCE tells me that he does not want to deny DIANE access to their mother however DIANE is irrational and very excited. He states that when DIANE visits their mother she upsets their mother and causes their mother distress.

BRUCE ANDERSON tells me that there are no court orders in effect

requiring that he grant DIANE access to their mother. I spoke with the custodian, TIM, on the telephone. He tells me also that DIANE ANDERSON has no legal right to visit with her mother. TIM tells me that DIANE will have the right to visit once her mother is placed in an assisted living facility however she has no legal right to visit while her mother is staying with BRUCE ANDERSON.

ASSAULT COMPLAINT: DIANE ANDERSON also informed me that she wanted to file a complaint for assault. DIANE ANDERSON tells me that when she arrived at BRUCE ANDERSON's house she saw BRUCE ANDERSON standing outside of the house near the west side of the garage. DIANE states that she announced to BRUCE ANDERSON that she was there to visit with their mother. DIANE ANDERSON then opened the pedestrian door to the garage and walked into the garage uninvited. DIANE ANDERSON tells me that she was walking towards the door between the garage and the house when BRUCE ANDERSON ran into the garage and demanded that she leave. DIANE ANDERSON states that she continued towards the house when BRUCE ANDERSON ran up and grabbed her. BRUCE ANDERSON began pushing DIANE ANDERSON towards the door.

DIANE ANDERSON states that she would like to file an assault complaint for this. I spoke to BRUCE ANDERSON about the assault.

BRUCE ANDERSON tells me that DIANE ANDERSON entered his garage while he was standing outside. BRUCE tells me that DIANE has no right to go into his garage and that she was not invited in. BRUCE tells me that he went into the garage and told DIANE to leave however DIANE continued towards the house. As DIANE was attempting to open the door to the house from the garage, BRUCE did physically restrain her and pushed DIANE towards the exterior door. BRUCE tells me that he had to physically restrain DIANE from going into the house because she did not respond to his verbal commands.

BRUCE ANDERSON tells me that IAN CALDWELL also was in the garage taking pictures and yelling things at him.

BRUCE ANDERSON does not want any criminal charges brought against either DIANE or IAN CALDWELL for illegal entry. BRUCE ANDERSON states that all he wants is for DIANE and IAN CALDWELL to leave his property.

INJURIES: Neither DIANE ANDERSON nor BRUCE ANDERSON received any injuries in the alleged assault.

DISPOSITION: No further action.

STATUS: Closed.
